ORDER

This matter came before the Court (Lowy, J.) on the respondent Kamah Gueh-Thoronka's papers titled, "Motion for Reinstatement to Practice Law in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts" and filed on January 17, 2023. The Office of Bar Counsel filed an opposition to said motion on February 14, 2023.

Previously, this matter came before the Court on a petition for reciprocal discipline against the respondent. After the parties' filed a waiver of hearing and assent to the entry of order, the Court, on September 21, 2021, issued an ORDER suspending the respondent from the practice of law in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts for an indefinite period retroactive to May 20, 2021, the effective date of the respondent's suspension in Maryland.

Upon consideration thereof, the respondent's motion for reinstatement be, and hereby is, DENIED without prejudice. See S.J.C. Rule 4:01, Section 18, para. 2(b), as appearing in 453 Mass. 1315 (2009), ("Except as the court by order may direct, a lawyer who has been suspended for an indefinite period may not petition for reinstatement until the expiration of at least three months prior to five years from the effective date of the order of suspension").
