

IN RE: DANIEL S. BRAESE

S.J.C. Judgment of Disbarment entered by Justice Botsford on December 8, 2011.¹

SUMMARY²

On November 2, 2011, an information was filed in the United States District Court for the District of Massachusetts charging the respondent with bank fraud in violation of 18 U. S. C. § 1344 and making false statements in Federal Housing Administration transactions in violation of 18 U. S. C. § 1010. On November 15, 2011, Daniel S. Braese filed in the Supreme Judicial Court for Suffolk County a waiver of hearing and consent to disbarment pursuant to S.J. C. Rule 4:01 §8(7), in which he acknowledged that bar counsel could prove the material facts set forth in the information by a preponderance of the evidence and that the facts were sufficient to establish violations of Mass. R. Prof. C. 1.2(a), 1.4(a) and (b), 1.15(c) and (d), and 8.4(b), (c), and (h). On December 8, 2011, the county court (Botsford, J.) entered a judgment of disbarment effective upon entry.
