S.J.C. Judgment of Disbarment entered by Justice Kafker on January 14, 2019.¹ SUMMARY²

This matter came before the Supreme Judicial Court for Suffolk County on an affidavit of resignation pursuant to S.J.C. Rule 4:01, § 15. The respondent was admitted in 2003.

In the affidavit of resignation, the respondent admitted that bar counsel could prove by a preponderance of the evidence that she had misappropriated \$164,454.57 for a client and that she has only repaid \$20,000 to date.

The respondent further admitted that a hearing committee, the board, and the Supreme Judicial Court would conclude that she had violated Mass. R. Prof. C. 1.15(b), 1.15(c), as in effect prior to July 1, 2015, and 8.4(c) and (h).

On December 10, 2018, the Board of Bar Overseers voted to recommend that the affidavit of resignation be accepted and that the respondent be disbarred. The Court so ordered on January 14, 2019.
